## ENTRIES CLOSE: Tuesday, July 18, 2023

VIHJA Benefit Show is a sanctioned Horse Council BC recognized event and governed by the current Horse Council BC Rule Book and Horse Council BC Safe Sport Member's Code of Conduct. All participants must abide by the Horse Council BC rules and Code of Conduct.

Entries payable by cash, cheque, or credit card. Payment is due by closing date or will be considered a late entry and charged accordingly. Online, mailed, or emailed entries will be accepted if accompanied by a credit card number. A parent or legal guardian must sign the entry for a junior exhibitor and the junior's birthdate must be given.

**Insurance: For insurance purposes, all competitors (owners, owners/agents and riders) must have the following three things:**

1. Horse Council BC Membership – can be purchased online at [www.hcbc.ca](http://www.hcbc.ca).
2. VIHJA FEE – The Vancouver Island Hunter Jumper Association is a non-profit organization committed to expanding and enhancing local equestrian competitions, clinics and other opportunities for its members. The VIHJA Fee covers jump equipment (standards, fillers, cups, timing equipment etc), allows VIHJA to subsidize clinics, and is required to ensure riders accrue their competition points in the year, gives members the ability to vote at the Annual General Meeting and other special meetings, and that liabilities are effectively managed for the club, show organizers, and participants. **\$25.00 fee per show.** Enquires can be directed to VIHJA ([mail@vihja.ca](mailto:mail@vihja.ca)).
3. Signed VIHJA Capri Insurance Waiver. *All riders, competitors, and trainers MUST sign a VIHJA Capri Insurance waiver prior to participating in the show. This waiver is separate from any SSITS waivers. This form is for VIHJA.*

**Dogs:** All dogs must be on a leash on the show grounds please.



**Scratches:** PRIOR TO THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW – Exhibitors canceling after closing date shall forfeit their entry fees except in the case of disability of entry. Entries will be refunded only upon the presentation to the show secretary a certificate of disability from a qualified veterinarian PRIOR TO THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW. A \$35.00 fee or 15% of entry (whichever is greater) will be charged on all cancellations.

**Post Entries:** Entries will be accepted at the discretion of management and at base cost + \$50.00

**Substitutions:** A new horse may be substituted for a scratched horse. There will be a \$20.00 substitution fee and all monies will be transferred to the new horse.

**Changes:** No adds will be permitted as all rounds will be running on an order-of-go system. No refunds for scratches.

**Entered and did not compete:** Any exhibitor who does not compete in class(es) in which the exhibitor is officially entered, and does not scratch according to the scratch procedures outlined above, will be billed for the class(es).

Refunds:

Cancellations before July 18: full refund

Cancellation between July 18 – August 1: 50% of all fees refunded

Cancellation after the start of the show: riders who are ill and not permitted to attend will receive a 50% refund. Cancellations due to any other reason will not be issued a refund.

**Protests:** Please refer to HCBC Rules Chapter 73. Protests must be in writing accompanied by a deposit of \$50.00 in cash, which shall be forfeited if the protest is not sustained. Should any dispute arise not provided for in the HCBC rules, local rules or prize list, it shall be referred to the show committee whose decision will be final.

**Stabling:** Overnight stabling (Wednesday – Sunday), bulk shavings available. Please indicate stabling on your entry form. Please indicate if you require stabling as of Tuesday afternoon/evening.

**Camping:** Is available on the grounds. Space may be limited. New this year, campers/tents/horse trailers with living quarters require a location number before unhooking.

Campers with power hookup, \$50.00 per night.

Campers without power hookup, \$40.00 per night.

Tents are considered as an RV without power, \$40.00 per night, and have always been counted by the Saanich Fairboard. As well, staying overnight in gooseneck horse trailers or in the back of horse trailers are counted by the Saanich Fairboard and charged the same way. The reason for this is because of the restroom and shower facilities the Saanich Fairgrounds provide to all visitors staying on site.

Please indicate days you are staying on your entry form. Any campers wishing to come early need permission from the Saanich Fairboard. If you wish to come in early or do not have a Benefit Show entry, please let Judy know and she will coordinate with the Fairboard. Water is NOT available for campers to use. The Saanich Fairboard will charge double for using their water. When arriving, please enter from horse show entrance, Gate 6, please do not use the main entrance.

**Protective headgear:** Must be worn at all Primary, Provincial, National Equine Canada and USEF sanctioned competitions. All competitors must wear proper fitting, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured at all times while mounted on competition or event grounds. Approved headgear must meet the ASTM standards and display the SEI seal. The British standard is also acceptable. Any rider violating this rule at any time will be immediately prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

**Numbers:** Must be worn and visible at all times when mounted.

**Champion & Reserve:** Show Championship and Reserve Championship, ribbons and prizes will be awarded upon the completion of each division in the ring. All classes must be entered in a division to be eligible for championship.

**Hors Concours:** Jumper Hors concours will be allowed at the discretion of management. No Hors concours in the hunter ring.

**VIHJA Year End Points:** Members receive points as per the 2023 VIHJA Rules at this show towards their year-end awards. Point classes will have an asterisk beside their name or division.

*Please refer to VIHJA 2023 Rules re: class eligibility and specifications.*

Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Management reserves the right to make changes of judges or class order to facilitate time schedule and condition, and the right to start the first class of any session 30 minutes earlier than the scheduled time if entries warrant.

**Certificate of Vaccinations:** VIHJA has implemented a vaccine requirement for all VIHJA sanctioned competitions. A vaccine certificate must be completed and received by the show office before you will be issued a show number.

The vaccine certificate will need to be filled out in part by your veterinarian. The veterinary endorsement on your vaccine certificate will remain valid for six months (the entire competition season).

## Certificate of Vaccinations



One form per horse is to be completed by the person responsible for the care of the horse ("Person Responsible") and a veterinarian and submitted to the Competition Office prior to receiving a competition number. Veterinarian endorsement will be valid and kept on file by VIHJA for six months from the date of the veterinarian's signature. A new Statement of Health must be completed by the Person Responsible prior to each VIHJA sanctioned competition.

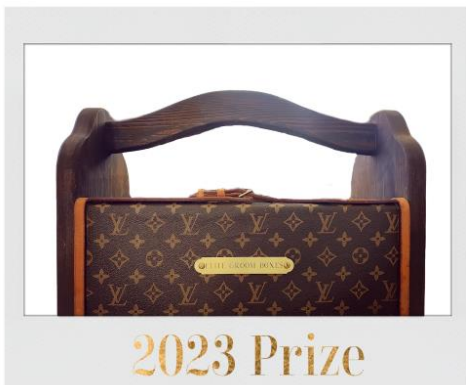

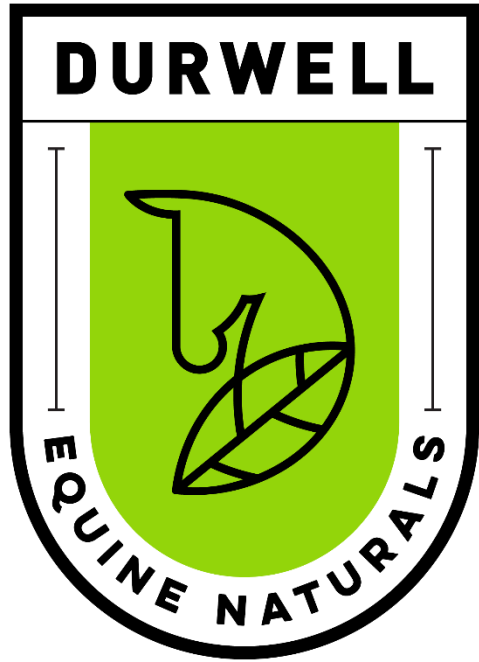

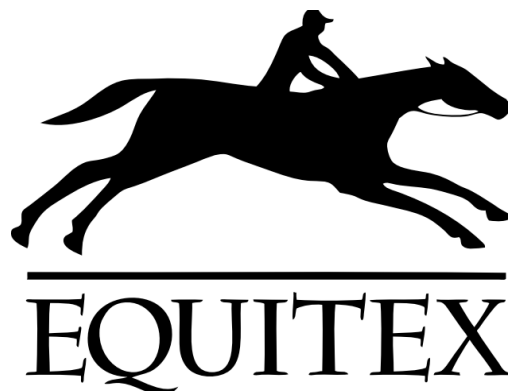
