The Vancouver Island Coastal Cowgirls are an equestrian drill team made up of 6 horse and rider teams. We have been performing together since 2014 and we all met through our local 4-H club. Since then we have performed at rodeos, fairs, and expos across western Canada.

With each performance we add elements that you would see in a reining pen like sliding stops, spins, and lead changes to set us apart from other drill teams.

Our performance is incomparable to anything you have seen before. If you like fast horses, loud music, and extreme skill then this is a show you will not want to miss.

EQUERRY SURGERY AND SPORTS MEDICINE ISLAND CUP CLASSIC TEAM CHALLENGE



Each team can have up to four riders one from each discipline a jumper, Reiner, Barrel racer and dressage horse. You may put your own team together if you know riders in all of the disciplines or we can put your team together as we will have an exciting collection of riders from all disciplines coming to compete.

Jumpers and Dressage will be on the grass arena while the Reining and Barrel racers will be on the sand with the first rider of each discipline beginning at 3:45pm. All disciplines will be running at the same time. Each discipline will be getting a score out of 100.

Jumpers will be scored on a fault and out system 5 points for every successful jump 1 point for knock down. 10 jump course to be completed in 60 seconds. Dressage Riders Reining and Barrel Racers will ride the test/patterns suited to their level of competition for a score out of 100. Each team can drop one score and results will be your teams best of three. Traditional attire but you may colour coordinate your team.

The six bar discipline

Fundamentally, the jumping discipline of six bar - also known as puissance - is about being the last pair standing. It's a high jump competition where there are six obstacles that get higher and higher. After each round, they're raised even more. The obstacles are placed one after the other, usually with two gallop strides between each. Sometimes the first two obstacles are placed separately on a long side, while the last four are placed on a diagonal or on the opposite long side. Each obstacle is a pole's height higher than the previous one, making the last one the biggest challenge for the pairing to overcome. If you knock down an obstacle you're out of the competition. The pair that remains without knocking anything down wins.

For this event there are a team of two riders on the course at the same time. The first rider starts their round and continues until they either have a fault (refusal or rail down), finish their round or the judge rings the bell. If a rider has a fault – rail down, the other rider takes over the round starting with the jump after the jump knocked down. If a rider has a refusal the other rider takes over the course at the jump refused (if it was knocked down during the refusal they must wait until it is put up again). If the first rider completes the round with no faults and the bell has not been rung the second rider takes over from jump No 1 and continues on. Swapping of riders when faults occur continues the same as above until the bell rings to finish the round. If the second rider is the one to finish the first round (i.e. the first rider had a fault) they continue on from the last jump to the first jump again. When the judge rings the bell your round is finished and you should jump the next jump in order. Then both riders must cross the finish line. The winning pair is the one which gets furthest along the course in the time allowed.

BUTET HUNT AND GO

In a Hunt & Go derby, riders do a longer course of twelve to sixteen jumps that is half classic and half handy. Each horse rider will receive a score out of 100 plus up to 10 handy points and up to 10 high option points.

Section 1 .75m with .9 high options

Section 2 .9 m with 1.1m high options.

Winner will receive a full set of Butet Equitation boots prizes to third Ribbons to 8th.

Equitation is the art or practice of horse riding/ horsemanship. More specifically, equitation may refer to a rider's position while mounted, and encompasses a rider's ability to ride correctly and with effective aids. In horse show competition, the rider, rather than the horse is evaluated. Judging criteria covers the rider's performance and control of the horse, use of riding aids, correct form, and usually factor in rider poise and the cleanliness and polish of horse, rider and equipment. The performance of the horse is not judged per se,

but a poorly performing horse is considered to reflect the ability of the rider. Equitation is a hybrid between hunters and jumpers where the riders abilities are tested over more difficult jumper type courses including hunting fences and gymnastic exercises.

Two heights/levels will be offered and judged as two classes:

Section 1 NOVICE .75M (open to horse/rider combinations that do not show higher than .85m in the show)

Section 2 ADVANCED 1M (open to all)

First place **Rider** in each section will be awarded a cooler and \$200 Gift Card. First place **Trainer** will be awarded a \$300 Gift Card. In each section ribbons to 8th place prizes to 6th.

PARCOURS DE CHASSE | Speed

A speed competition differs in that the horse/rider combination typically negotiates one round with speed becoming the key determining factor overall. The ultimate winner of the competition will be the pair of athletes who cross the finish line with the least faults and the fastest time over the one round. In the Parcours de Chasse, knockdowns are converted into seconds, making it possible for a very fast horse that has a rail down still win the event, so look for the turns to become a little tighter and the pace a little quicker once the rail falls. Obviously, the best route to victory is still a fast clear round, but anything can happen when the speed horses are on course.

2'6" / .75M OPEN TO ALL



Hunter hack is a type of English pleasure class where exhibitors in Hunt seat tack and attire perform on the flat at a walk, trot, canter and hand gallop, and then jump two-three low fences (2'6" / .75m). The desired horse in this competition is to resemble a quiet, well-mannered working hunter.

Hunter hacks are scored on their manners, movement, and conformation, as well as their ability to jump with an even arc and stride over the center of the fences. The under saddle is 70% and over fence is 30% of the score.

The Hunter Derby is two rounds. The Classic Hunter Round (first round) is judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, and movement. The traditional first round will offer three to four high options for additional 2 points. Second round Handiness is to be judged on unique turns, direct approaches, and inside turns. The handy ride should be bold and showcase the horse's rideability. If there is a rider change from First to Second round you will be awarded an additional ten points to the final score.

Two heights are offered but judged together:

First height .75 with .9 options **Second height** .9 with 1.1m high options.

Ribbons to 10th place. Diamonds to third place and diamond themed prizes to 10th.
